Missed opportunities and overheated media

Last debate... at last

Wednesday, October 19, the last presidential candidates' debate was staged in Las Vegas and, thankfully, it was the *last*. Most estimates by the "non-media" had Donald Trump ahead of Hillary Clinton, scoring better on the issues. We wouldn't know that if we simply listened to the state-run media coverage, including that on the *Fox* network.

All the media could discuss, sickening in repetition, was Trump's response to moderator Chris Wallace's dizzy, out-of-nowhere "last question." One *Associated Press (AP)* headline read: "Donald Trump refuses to accept election results." Stated in the *AP* piece, Donald Trump, based on his answer to Wallace's question, posed "a threat to upend a basic pillar of American democracy." No reference at all to Al Gore's election challenges; no mention of press sources calling the race for John Kerry in 2004, based on *exit polling*. Trump's inarticulate response to a pointless question, unasked of Hillary, was all that mattered.

Fox News debate moderator Chris Wallace did a better job than his predecessors in keeping the candidates on the issues and away from the media-generated "mud," but his "gotcha" question was saved for last. He asked Trump if he would respect the results of the election (as if this will determine which candidate is selected by voters). It was the ridiculous "pledge" scenario from the Republican primary debates all over again: embarrass Trump as the outsider who "doesn't understand the 'rules'." Inside the Beltway pundit types were unhinged, once more revealing their disgust for Trump ("He's definitely not one of us").

Donald Trump did well on the issues but, as in previous debates, he didn't take the slow pitches from Hillary. Likely due to debate inexperience, he let these float by.

In the question concerning SCOTUS, the Supreme Court of the United States, Hillary's typically socialist answer should have been belted over the fence by Trump.

She stated that, under a Clinton Stage Two presidency, the SCOTUS would "stand up" for all of us and "should represent all of us."

It should have been obvious to Trump that Hillary's answer revealed she doesn't like the system we have in this country. We have a *legislative branch* of government that represents "all of us." The SCOTUS' sole purpose is the interpretation of law according to the original intent of the Constitution. They simply interpret the law; they don't make it and they don't enforce it.

Wallace's question on the Second Amendment (gun control) could have been "trumped" in a similar fashion. The U.S. Constitution and its amendments are *above* the SCOTUS; changes can only be made through the amendment processes set down in the Constitution. (Trump could have said the Second Amendment is for citizens' defense against tyrannical government!)

The state-run media, predictably, concentrated on the *least important* topic in the debate: Trump's response to the "election results" question from Wallace.

Completely ignored was Mrs. Clinton's violation of the Espionage Act, when she announced how much time it takes from the president's order to launch a nuclear strike until the warheads actually leave for their targets. The American populace may have missed the import of her illegal remarks, but others didn't. North Korea was listening, Russia was listening, Red China and the mullahs in Iran were listening.

Along with the public's sigh of relief at the passing of the last presidential debate, a question remains unanswered: Did Hillary discuss a price with our enemies, before she agreed to expose confidential security info under the cover of a debate?

Hillary's DNC 'stick'

Democrats consistently launch propaganda at an ineffective Republican Party. Jack's brothers Teddy and Bobby were also intensely amorous with women to whom they were not married, particularly Teddy's under-the-table activities with waitresses in restaurants. Then there's the lewd and lascivious behavior of LBJ and decades of abuse of women by Bill Clinton.

Many other politicians on the Left engaged in immoral activity, and not simply locker room vulgarity or inappropriate actions toward women other than their spouses: the names Jonathan Edwards, Gary Hart, Jesse Jackson, Elliot Spitzer, and Anthony Weiner readily come to mind. Add the immoral acts of tax fraud, tax evasion, and pay-to-play schemes among hundreds of "despicable" on the Left and you have one serious menagerie of immorality.

Republican leadership needs to call out the faux moral outrage evidenced by the leftist press toward Trump as *laughable*.

Hillary Clinton's presidential campaign has been exposed as the partner and beneficiary of a dedicated network of experienced radical activists.

Newly released undercover video interviews from James O'Keefe of *Project Veritas*, conducted by his stealth journalists, have exposed the fascist underbelly of the Left's "campaign assistance" organizations.

In cover-ups for the Obama Regime scandals and diversion for the Clinton campaign shenanigans, the collusion between the press, the Democrat National Committee (DNC) and its operatives, and the Clinton campaign is now in the open, thanks to *Project Veritas'* dedicated journalists.

Bob is a frequent visitor at the White House (at least 342 times) and is well known by the president (47 private meetings).

Scott Foval admitted in the video that, "I am contracted to him (Bob Creamer). But I answer to the head of special events for the DNC and the head of the special events and political for the campaign... The campaign (Hillary Clinton) pays DNC (Democrat national Committee); DNC pays *Democracy Partners*; *Democracy Partners* pays the *Foval Group*; the *Foval Group* goes and executes the s**t on the ground." He continued, explaining how the "execution" works: "If you're there and you're protesting and you do these actions, you will be

attacked at Trump rallies. That's what we want." Then Foval added, "The whole point of it is that we know Trump's people will freak the [expletive] out, his security team will freak out, and his supporters will lose their [expletive]."

The DNC inserts paid activists to disrupt the event, to antagonize Trump supporters to attack the hired leftist agitators. The media then proceeds to write the story that Trump's supporters are causing the mayhem. Mission accomplished.

According to Aaron Black (an alias), a DNC rapid response coordinator interviewed on tape by *Veritas*, "Nobody is really supposed to know about me." He explained the ruse. "So the Chicago protest, when they shut all that, that was us. It was more him (Bob Creamer) than me, but none of this is supposed to come back to us, because we want it coming from people, we don't want it to come from the party."

So the DNC and Clinton campaign fingerprints are nowhere to be found. The chaos created is covered by the press, saying Trump's campaign supporters are inciting violence. But activist groups on the Left admit they're responsible for the public violence and civil unrest, and have been doing so for decades. They plan and deliver it upon attendees at peaceful political rallies, yet state-run media sources consistently get it wrong, intentionally.

The system *is* "rigged," so to speak, as far as the average, right-of-center voter is concerned. Media won't expose the deceit and intimidation methods of the Left.
