According to Dave Wasserman at the *Cook Political Report*, of 227 million eligible voters in the United States, Hillary Clinton gathered 28.8% of the votes cast and Donald Trump captured 27.7%. Those who voted for other candidates amounted to 3.2%. Sadly for our republic, 40.3% of those eligible didn't bother to show up.

There are 3,141 counties in the United States; Donald Trump won 3,084 of them and Hillary Clinton won 57.

The January 20 inauguration of Donald Trump as 45th President of the United States will be anything but "text book." Character assassins

Perhaps Rush Limbaugh voiced it best last week, at least the most succinct I've heard: "Democrats haven't been this mad since Lincoln freed the slaves."

The Thirteenth Amendment to the U.S. Constitution abolished slavery (ratified December 6, 1865), completing what President Abraham Lincoln began with his Emancipation Proclamation in 1863. Republican Party support was 100% for the amendment; Democrat Party, only 23%.

The Fourteenth Amendment guaranteed citizenship to the slaves set free by the Thirteenth and was ratified by the states on July 9, 1868. Republican Party support was 94%; Democrat Party, 0%.

Voting rights were guaranteed by the Fifteenth Amendment (ratified on February 3, 1870) to all those awarded citizenship by the Fourteenth and granted freedom by the Thirteenth. Again, Republican support was 100%; Democrat support was 0%.

When it came to "human rights," the members of this leftist party were absent. In the push for civil rights during the 1960s, the Republicans pulled the Democrats along the road to equality, despite their objections. Today, Democrats take credit for the achievements of others through revisionist history; their "base" buys the propaganda.

The unread Affordable Care Act (Obamacare) passed on March 23, 2010 with no support from Republicans (0%) and 86% support from Democrats. Black Americans, along with all others, now pay more for less under Obamacare's restricted access, exorbitant costs and illegal mandates.

Employment opportunities for black Americans have been hit hardest by the Democrats' insistence on open borders and unrestricted illegal immigration.
