Abraham Lincoln accepted his party's nomination to be its candidate for the U.S. Senate from the state of Illinois on June 16, 1858. Lincoln faced the delegates at the Illinois Republican State Convention in Springfield that day and gave a warning that the republic would not likely continue if it didn't correct its course... "A house divided against itself cannot stand."

Although his efforts to win the seat failed, the speech he delivered on that date was an address that defined the nation's critical division and the dire consequences that could be expected if that division was not rectified. It defined him in his run for the presidency two years later and is etched in U.S. History...

We are now far into the fifth year, since a policy was initiated, with the avowed object, and confident promise, of putting an end to slavery agitation.

Under the operation of that policy, that agitation has not only not ceased, but has constantly augmented. In my opinion, it will not cease, until a crisis shall have been reached, and passed - a house divided against itself cannot stand.

I believe this government cannot endure, permanently half slave and half free.

I do not expect the Union to be dissolved — I do not expect the house to fall but I do expect it will cease to be divided.

In 2017, the division is no longer North or South. The "agitation" is no longer about race, or subjugation of a race, though in the last eight years the Obama administration sought to "augment" it anew, striving for racial division in its progressive agenda of chaos and control, as in Ferguson, Missouri and Baltimore, Maryland.
